
## TOP 10 REASONS TO CARRY FIX-A-STITCH IN YOUR KNITTING BAG ...

FIX-A-STITCH users quickly master making a purl repair from the front of their fabric without removing the tool or turning their work.

Knitters appreciate the ease and efficiency provided by the FIX-A-STITCH tool and method. We often hear "now I can finish that project I put aside because it had a mistake."



Knitters using the FIX-A-STITCH method more easily grasp the "knit bar/purl bar" concept, reducing frustration.

FIX-A-STITCH used as a cable needle stays in the yarn and you can use FIX-A-STITCH to twist cabled stitches to tighten the cable design.

Twisted stitches (as in a faux seam) are conveniently created after the fact, and look much nicer than those made with a normal "crochet hook"



FIX-A-STITCH is light and parks in your work, available when you need it for repairs, or even for binding off or creating a decorative edge.
